## Assistant Professor Position in Cellular and Molecular Physiology

The Department of Biological Sciences at The University of Alabama invites applications for a full-time (9-month) tenure-track faculty position at the rank of **Assistant Professor** in **Cellular and Molecular Physiology** to begin Fall 2018. Applicants with research interests in all areas of cellular and molecular physiology, with a broad focus on understanding mechanisms by which cell signaling gives rise to complex physiological functions in response to environmental factors (biotic or abiotic), are encouraged to apply. Applicants using model or non-model organisms with expertise in optogenetics, *in vivo* genetic techniques, and/or systems biology approaches are encouraged to apply. The successful applicant will be expected to establish an extramurally funded and internationally recognized research program in Cellular and Molecular Physiology. Teaching responsibilities will include basic undergraduate courses in cellular physiology and biology, as well as graduate courses in the successful candidate's area of expertise. Depending on the applicant's expertise, he or she may also have the opportunity to teach a course in microscopy research applications and serve as Director of the UA Optical Analysis Facility.

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in the Biological Sciences or related field, postdoctoral (or equivalent job) experience, demonstrated excellence in research, and a commitment to excellence in teaching and the training of undergraduate and graduate students.
